SMART Board Interactive Whiteboard Basics, Wed. September 19, 3:45 - 5:00 PM

This touch-sensitive interactive whiteboard connects to the computer and projector and enables you to control all computer applications directly from the display. It is a powerful medium for engaging students and audiences, and has several tools for enhancing teaching, creating lessons, and delivering presentations.

Creating SMART Board Interactive Lessons with Notebook, Tues. October 2, 3:45 – 5:00 PM

Enhance content and motivate students with interactive lessons using Notebook software tools. Create your own lessons or assessments, modify existing resources, and integrate multi-media content. Instruction is modified and tailored as per the needs of the students.

SMART Response PE – Interactive Response System for K-12, Wed. October 10, 3:45 – 5:00 PM

Get students engaged and motivated using response pads or "clickers." These small, handheld devices enable students to quickly respond to questions asked verbally, or on paper, or screen. Teachers can create planned or spontaneous quizzes, and instantly tally responses, and generate reports. Use these response pads with the SMART Notebook software, and add interactive and multimedia content to the assessments.

Zoho Basics: Going Beyond Microsoft Office! Thurs. November 1, 3:45 – 5:00 PM

Microsoft Office Suite not available? No need to panic, just use Zoho! Zoho's online content sharing and group collaboration allows student and teachers to stay connected beyond the classroom. Zoho's Wiki enables educators to create interactive course content. Zoho's Challenge allows teachers to create tests and quizzes with a variety of question types. Zoho is compatible with Microsoft Office - work online and upload Microsoft Office documents into Zoho, or work offline and open Zoho documents in Microsoft Office.

Using SMARTBoard with Children's Literature, Monday, November 12, 3:45 – 5:00 PM

This workshop will explore combining the use of print materials with digital resources. The one-hour workshop will include hands-on experimentation with the interactive whiteboard, development of a basic SMART Board lesson, and the evaluation of age-appropriate children's literature through the use of websites and databases.
