In 2008, the Legislature enacted Chapter 484 of the Laws of 2008, which further amends Sections 3004(4) and (5) of the Education Law by extending the timeframe for those applying for a teaching certificate or license as a special education teacher to complete such course work or training from February 2, 2007 to September 2, 2009. The new legislation also clarifies that school administrators must complete training in the needs of autistic children as soon as practicable after their assignment. Certified school administrators or supervisors assigned to serve as special education administrators prior to September 2, 2009 are required to have enhanced training in the needs of children with autism by such date.

From the WEST

L.I. Expressway to Exit 39 (Glen Cove Rd). Go North to Northern Blvd (Route 25 A). Turn Right. Go 2 miles to LIU, Post Campus (Tilles Center)- West Gate. Turn right onto Post Lane. Humanities Hall is in the middle of campus (towards your left), south of the library and North of the Tilles Center. If you cannot find parking in the lots to your left, pass the Tilles Center and park in the Southern lots. Then walk through Hillwood Commons. When you exit the building on the North side, follow the path to the first building on your left.

From the EAST

L.I. Expressway. to Exit 41N (Rt.107). Go North on 107, bear left at fork where 106 & 107 split. Turn left onto Northern Blvd (Rt 25A). Go 1/8th mile to 1st light and turn left into LIU Post. Make immediate right onto University Dr. At 2nd stop (W. Gate), turn left onto Post Lane. Humanities Hall is in the middle of campus (towards your left), south of the library and North of the Tilles Center. If you cannot find parking in the lots to your left, pass the Tilles Center and park in the Southern lots. Then walk through Hillwood Commons. When you exit the building on the North side, follow the path to the first building on your left.
