Dr. Miriam (Miri) Amit is Professor of Mathematics Education and was until recently the Dean at Ben-Gurion University at Eilat, after being the Director of the Israel Center for Science and Technology Education at Ben-Gurion University of the Negev.

Dr. Amit received her B.Sc. and M.Sc. in Mathematics and Physics, with highest honors, from the Technion, the Israel Institute of Technology, and her Ph.D. from the Department of Mathematics and Computer Sciences at Ben-Gurion University of the Negev.

Published more than 200 articles, books and curriculum combining research and practice.

- 12 years as the Chief National Superintendent of Mathematics at the Israel Ministry of Education
- Leads programs aimed at Improving Access to Higher Education for students from low socio-economic areas
- Her interest areas are: Excellence Creativity and Equity, Teacher Education, Assessment and Educational Policy, and Multiculturalism and Ethno-mathematics
- She is the recipient of the Guastella award for the advancement of STEM education, British Council Award for World Leaders in Mathematics Education, IOWME award for research on Gender in Mathematics.
