### The Austrian Landscape and the Diversity Beliefs of Students

Dr. Ulrike Greiner, Doz, DDr., is Dean of the School of Education at the University of Salzburg since 2016.

Furthermore, she is a senior lecturer at the University of Innsbruck. In 2005 she was appointed as a university professor (W3) at the University of Dortmund. Before, she taught for 10 years at a couple of schools, was involved in teachers' education (teaching, research development, curricula development) and since 2006 she has been involved in university management (founding rector of the University College for Teacher Education in Vienna and Upper Austria). Her focal points of scientific research are:

- In the areas of research of teachers' competencies, especially teachers' epistemological beliefs
- Core concepts of subjects in school at the secondary level of education
- Research in the assessment and development of pedagogical knowledge within the context of diversity and heterogeneity at school.
